

## NAVY Swimming Camp UPDATE #4 posted 14 June 2021

**Greetings from Navy Swimming Camp.** Just hours and counting before the start of Session I. The schedule for session I will be shared on Tuesday 15 June (for session I) & on Monday June 21st (for session II.) Please note the following pieces of information in advance to the daily schedule.

**Traveling to camp.** See Camp Update #3 for instructions on traveling to camp. We will have camp swimming staff posted at the stadium (near the Blue Angel display.) Please bear in mind that this is where you will say your farewells to your swimmer(s) as only campers and staff can travel on the bus. You will enter at Gate 5. There is a parking charge for this lot (\$10.00/day.) You are free to park elsewhere and walk to the stadium to avoid this charge. *Please note that Navy Swimming Camp has no affiliation with the parking vendor and does not receive any funds collected for parking.*



### Shuttle Schedule for Tuesday June 15th (Session I) & Monday June 21st (Session II)

**Tuesday June 15:** Beginning at 12:00pm, a courtesy shuttle bus is available to bring you from the stadium to the Naval Academy (Lejeune Hall drop off.) Travel to and park at NAVY MARINE MEMORIAL STADIUM (550 Taylor AVE, Annapolis, MD.) Drive into Gate 5 off of Taylor Avenue. Park then proceed to Gate Z of the Stadium near the Blue Angel display (same location as 2019 for returning campers), Coaches will be posted at the stadium parking lot as well to assist with the process as well. Please note this is not a continuous shuttle. We expect the bus to depart for the Naval Academy no later than 12:15pm. The shuttle will depart the Naval Academy at 5:45pm. We expect your swimmer(s) will arrive at the stadium by 6:00pm. *Please note the schedule for day one is different from the other days of camp. All campers (Day and Extended Day) will remain with us until they return to the stadium at 6:00pm.*

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Despite the Naval Academy still being closed, I did want to share with you the below map of USNA. For those who have not been on campus, *the Yard* is it is known, we are the second building from the bottom right. Lejeune Hall has been our home base since 1982 and 1999 when the Navy Swimming Camp began.



**NEW in 2021! COVID procedures.** We will review all with the campers on day one. However did want to share the following with you at this time.

- A health screening survey will be sent from [navyswimmingcamp@usna.edu](mailto:navyswimmingcamp@usna.edu) each morning to the email on file. This must be completed to get onto the shuttle bus.
- Campers and staff required to wear a mask on the shuttle bus (regardless of vaccination.)
- A temperature check will be administered each morning and just prior to getting on the shuttle as well. If a camper/staff member temperature reads 100F or higher, we will wait 15 minutes and try again. If the temperature remains 100F or higher, we will direct the camper/staff member to call their primary care provider or State Department of Health for further direction. *We realize we have some parents who are medical professionals and may follow different procedures. This is what has been determined by our medical professionals & will serve as our marching orders throughout camp.*
- Face covering required to enter outdoor dining tents (if not fully immunized), can remove face covering while eating.
- RESTROOMS. Face coverings are required to be worn to/from bathroom.

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### ***COVID procedures continued***

- **INDOOR ACTIVITIES.** Fully immunized campers and staff (two weeks beyond final dose) are no longer required to wear a face covering. Unimmunized campers and staff are required to wear a face covering at all times – only time can remove face covering is aerobic activity or eating/drinking. *NOTE: This is an overall athletic camp policy. We are going to remain slightly more conservative and expect masks when not in the water. Coaches will be masked however with masks down when instructing.*
- **OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES.** Fully immunized campers and staff (two weeks beyond final dose) are no longer required to wear a face covering. Unimmunized campers and staff are required to wear a face covering at all times – only time can remove face covering is aerobic activity or eating/drinking.

**Spirit Wear Reminder.** See CAMP Update #3 (posted 9 June 2021) for actual listing of items.

***Important.*** Please note that we will not be in close proximity to the phones for most of the day on June 15th then again on the 21st as camp gets going. Please leave a message if you have an important update regarding your camper(s). We will do our best to promptly reply towards the end of the day. Please continue to use the camp email address for any other inquiries. Thank you in advance.

***Also important.*** If you are planning to remove your camper(s) from camp for any reason, please submit this request in writing. This includes any early check out. We will follow up in writing with best available times. Location will always be the scorer's desk in Lejeune Hall. In recent camp seasons, we have experienced a greater than normal number of unannounced early departures from camp. These unannounced pick ups and/or early check outs delay the process for everyone.

We look forward to the challenge and efforts to be put forth by the entire group this week.
